## NEXT VENUE INFO

### BROMBOROUGH ...IT'S ON THE WIRRAL

Although the Wirral may seem a long way, it is easily accessible and actually almost as close to our base in Mold than today's venue here in Wrexham.

### BROMBOROUGH VILLAGE....

Bromborough Civic is located on Allport Lane with the main Bromborough Village street on the other.

### BY ROAD

By road from the Chester/North Wales direction join the A41 at Hooton and head for Birkenhead for a couple of miles taking a left turn just after a Church into Bromborough Village. Turn left at the Cross down 'The Rake' taking 2<sup>nd</sup> left and immediately left again into the Car Park adjacent to the venue. Parking is FREE all day. SAT NAV postcode CH62 7HR

### RAIL

Via the Chester-Liverpool line with **Bromborough Rake** being your stop **NOT** Bromborough station. The Rake is the next station after Bromborough from the Chester direction.

Simply follow the road STRAIGHT for about ¼ mile into Bromborough Village. Trains are usually about every 15 minutes.

### ADDITIONAL VILLAGE INFO

\* Plenty of places to eat and drink in this lovely Village, also a couple of Wine Bars, Pubs very close by.

\*For those who want extra retail therapy there is a large retail park on the outskirts of the Village which hosts many of the major High Street retailers.
